Gender Pay Gap Report



We are committed to maintaining a positive and inclusive working environment.

This includes ensuring that individuals have equal access to jobs and that staff are also paid equally for carrying out the same or equivalent roles.

Median Pay Gap

Men's and women's hourly rate is the same.

Mean Pay Gap

Women's hourly rate is 5.85% more than men's.

ENO strives to maintain a working environment where pay is broadly equivalent irrespective of gender. The balance between male and female remains largely the same across the wider organisation from the previous year.

The rates of pay remain broadly the same throughout the organisation.

Our overall mean and median gender pay gap is based on hourly rates of pay as of 5 April 2025.


No bonus was paid in the year.

51.96% of the ENO's workforce are women.




Lower Quartile




Lower Middle Quartile
